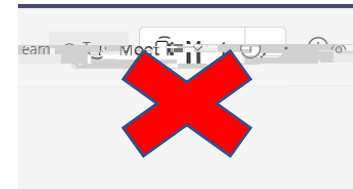
1. Open [Microsoft Teams](#) on your computer.
2. Click the [Teams icon](#) on the left-hand side of the Teams window



You can start a new conversation or add comments and reactions to existing ones, just like other parts of the Teams software. This is an open forum visible to staff and students at DMU. Only staff and students with a current DMU IT account login will be able to become members.

You can also access the forms via the Fill tab at the top of each Teams forum. If the tab is not showing, you may need to select the pull-down menu to the right of the Files tab.

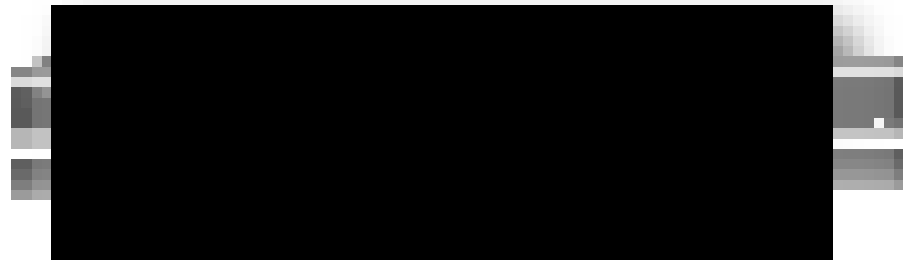
